Grace Christian School is operated by Gladstone Assembly of God, a 501c3 non-profit religious organization. Tax deductible contributions may be sent to:

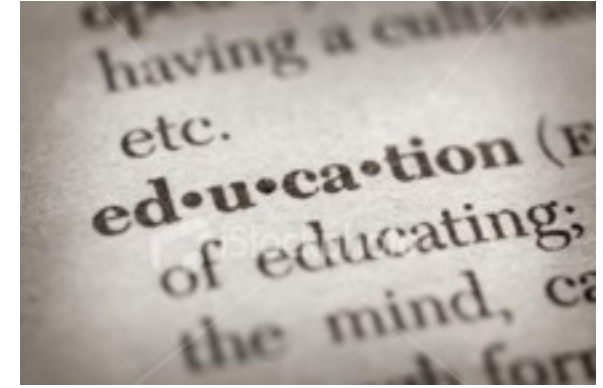

We are now in the process of expanding our facilities to provide increased enrollment in our high school program. Building for the future

Our vision is to continue growing and improving Grace Christian School into a fully accredited Pre-K – 12 school, while maintaining our goal of making private Christian education attainable for all families.

Our school is operated by, and shares facilities with, Gladstone Assembly of God. This cost-effective partnership provides us access to a 4.5 acre property, and over 10,000 sq. Ft. of classrooms, offices, and worship space. Our campus is located in the heart of Gladstone with convenient access to I-205 and 99E.

We currently have planning approval to add two modular buildings and increase our enrollment from 225 students to 300. We intend to have the new buildings ready for occupancy in the Fall of 2007, supporting an additional 75 students in grades 7-12. Future plans include a gymnasium, library, and newer, larger classrooms.

Private Christian education is a tremendous blessing to families seeking to raise their children to be strong, effective Christians in a world that is increasingly hostile to our faith. We hope you’ll support our efforts to improve this valuable ministry.

GCS Capital Fund

The GCS Capital Fund has been established to meet the capital needs of Grace Christian School. Money expended from this fund will be used for projects primarily motivated by school needs, and which offer significant benefits to school operations. It is acknowledged that the school is a ministry of, and shares property and facilities with the church. Therefore, expenditures from this fund may result in residual benefit to the church.

This fund will be used exclusively for:

Facilities development, including purchase or lease of portable classrooms, building renovations, construction of new buildings, property improvements (i.e. playing fields, parking, fencing)

Equipment and Technology, including computers, networking and telecom equipment, audio visual equipment, laboratory equipment, playground equipment
