Five Reasons To Support This Effort

- 85% of children from Christian homes that attend public school, leave the church after High School
- There is a growing, unmet need for affordable Christian High School education in this area.
- It is illegal for public schools to teach anything from a Christian perspective.
- A Christian High School will support, not undermine, your efforts to raise your children "in the way that they should go."
- Only 6% of public school children who come from Christian homes have a biblical worldview.

What will it take to make it happen?

Although there are many things which must be accomplished to make this vision a reality, there are two areas which are key to this effort.

First, we must obtain a Conditional Use permit for expansion of our existing facilities. This will involve an application process with public hearings, and a decision being rendered by the Gladstone Planning Commission. We expect to begin this process informally in the very near future, and intend to present a formal application by early 2007.

Second, we must raise sufficient funds to carry out the facilities expansion plan. This will be the most ambitious fund raising effort in our history.

We would like to add space for about 100 students. This will most likely involve the acquisition and installation of modular classrooms, plus the required furnishings and equipment. Total cost will depend on a number of factors, but could be as high as \$250,000.
